

## ADDRESS ASSIGNMENT

**Our #1 Priority is Emergency Response Time** 

#### **DESCRIPTION**

A valid street address is required to apply for a building or zoning permit. If your property does not yet have an address, application can be made through the Development Center. Addresses are assigned by the Engineering Department in consultation with 9-1-1 services.

The City of Columbia Code of Ordinances Section 5-261 thru 5-266 requires that every building within the corporate limits of the city shall be numbered as designated by the city engineer. Furthermore, the SC State Code of Laws Section 23-47-60 Addressing requires that local government, upon approval for implementation of a 9-1-1 system, shall standardize addressing within its area according to service supplier procedures. Both Code of Ordinances and Code of Laws are available upon request.

#### **PROCESS**

- Submit Address request form and supporting information to the Development Center;
- Owner will be notified of address assignment by letter.

#### **INFORMATION TO PROVIDE**

Completed Address Request from with the following attachment(s):

- For Existing lots: Copy of recorded plat (can be obtained from Richland County Register of Deeds, if available);
- For Newly Subdivided Lot: Recorded copy of City of Columbia approved plat;
- For Apartments/Malls: Floor plan/store layout;
- For new tenant space within an existing building: Building floor plan showing the layout of suites, units, etc., include all existing addresses.

#### TIME

3-5 Days. Possibly longer depending on circumstances.
